

Awards & Recognition Ad-Hoc Committee Recommendation

The chapter confirmed the creation of an Awards & Recognition Ad-hoc committee in September 2010. The charge of this committee was to review the current award system and criteria and make a recommendation to the chapter for a revised Award and Recognition program. Below you will see the current awards offered by the chapter and by alumni.

Recommended Award Changes

Award	Criteria
Value (1) <i>Thomas Hutsell Award for Value</i>	Voted on by the chapter; goes to a brother initiated within the semester that shows the most potential and has exhibited best the principles of Sigma Tau Gamma Fraternity
Benefit (2) <i>Robert N. Jones Award for Benefit</i>	The brother who has the most community service hours (not including philanthropy)
Learning (3) <i>Emmett Ellis Award for Learning</i>	The brother(s) with the highest G.P.A.
Integrity <i>Earl A. Webb Award for Integrity</i>	Runner-up for the Benny Oliver Brotherhood (fall) / Mauer Man Of The Year (spring)
Leadership <i>William Hembree Award for Leadership</i>	Voted on by the chapter; goes to an active brother involved in an organization or club outside of the chapter. This brother has best embodied the principle of leadership throughout the past semester. Everyone in a leadership position outside of the chapter is eligible for this recognition. The top three candidates will present their organization's duties and responsibilities prior to the final vote.

Excellence
*Edward H. McCune Award for
Excellence*

The recipient of this award will have received the highest score on the chapter's metrics. Points will be distributed as follows:

1 point for every .10 over a 2.5 GPA (prior semester)

1 point for every 5 hours of community service beyond 15 hours (chapter min.)

1 point for every 5 intramural hours (not to exceed 3 points)

2 points for every leadership position held outside of the fraternity - Ω

1 point for every 5 brotherhoods/recruitment events attended

†-Standard voting procedures apply to all awards with voting for selection

Δ -Minimum chapter requirements must be met to be considered eligible for any chapter awards.

§-Standard rounding applies to all awards

Ω -Leadership position is defined as an elected or appointed position in a committee, organization, or club.

The Executive Vice President in conjunction with the Judicial Board of the Beta Kappa will determine eligibility prior to the nomination process.

Therefore, the Awards & Recognition Ad-hoc Committee recommends the aforementioned award changes with the attached criterion. It is our recommendation that this become effective immediately and a review be conducted in the first weeks of the spring semester.
